A vibrant selection of more than 120 artists from across the nation, will gather in Royal Oak to exhibit and sell diverse works of art, including talented newcomers and beloved returning favorites

New! – Glassblowing Demonstrations

One dynamic new art focused initiative for this year will come from **Glass Academy** through an incredible partnership with the iconic **Maker's Mark** brand, is aiming to transform old Maker's Mark bottles into stunning works of art. This innovative collaboration will be showcased through captivating live glassblowing demonstrations at the highly anticipated Arts Beats & Eats event. Attendees will have the unique opportunity to witness skilled artists breathe new life into these discarded bottles, turning them into mesmerizing glass artworks right before their eyes.

New! – Emerging Artists Program

Arts, Beats and Eats will host an Emerging Artist Program within the Corewell Health Juried Fine Art Show. This program aims to promote and showcase new and starting artists at the festival including: [Dylan Kamalaya](#) (Jewelry) of Cleveland, Ohio, who started creating small batches of handmade lightweight clay earrings in 2019 with a focus on showcasing the beauty of water and its fluidity; and [Jameson Marden](#) (Glass) of Midland, Michigan, an emerging glass-fusing artist whose works are inspired by nature and his travels, resulting in colorful and playful pieces that pop in any setting.

Corewell Health Juried Fine Art Show

Top artists from across the nation will be onsite throughout the festival's more than 125 booths featuring art in a vast selection of styles and mediums, including ceramics, digital art, drawing / pastels, fabric/fiber/leather, glass, graphics/printmaking, jewelry, metal, mixed media 2D and 3D, painting, photography, sculpture and wood. These artists will be competing to win cash awards totaling more than \$7,000, including the top three "Best in Show" and "Awards of Excellence" in each of the respective categories mentioned.

"We are excited to welcome many new and returning artists to this year's Corewell Health Juried Fine Art Show," said Shannon Wojtas, Art Director, Soaring Eagle Arts, Beats & Eats. "It's a very competitive environment with some of the most talented artists from across the country in so many

varying categories of art vying for a spot in the show. Each year, Soaring Eagle Arts, Beats & Eats' Juried Fine Art Show selects some of the best of the best, and it is the reason, among many, that it continues to be one of the first-class shows out of the thousands nationwide."

New Artists

New artists to this year's festival include: [Glen Etheridge](#) (Drawing) of Racine, Wisconsin, whose inspired creations include intricate capturing of scenes including old tools, glass, flowers and more; [Shelly Knupp](#) (Glass) from Dayton, Ohio, whose works stem from an appreciation for the transformative power of creativity fired into glass; [Craig Roderick](#) (Photography) of Jasper, Alabama, an expert photographer specializing in capturing mother nature's unique intricacy's in the form of flowers without the distractions of normal backgrounds; and [Georgie LeHoop](#) (Mixed Media 2D) of St. Clair, Pennsylvania, whose very unique style began with his love of drumming, which then led to adding paint to the mix and creating pieces that showcase a captivating process and demonstration of skill that leave a lasting impression.

Returning Artists

Returning artists to this year's festival include: [Adam Hoffman](#) (Digital Art/Graphics) of Salt Lake City, Utah, who designed this year's limited edition Arts, Beats & Eats commemorative poster, creates stunning fractal pieces that are made using geometry and mathematical equations; [Antoine Terhune](#) (Jewelry) from Harrison Twp., Michigan, will showcase his ultra-unique rings and precious jewelry; [Angela Welti](#) (Jewelry) from Okemos, Michigan, who boasts an impressive track record of crafting award-winning jewelry from knots and fiber for more than four decades; [Cheri Rhodig](#) (Mixed Media 3D) from Lakeland, Florida, who handcrafts small robot figurines using found objects and 95 percent recycled materials; and [Julie Roth](#) (Painting) from West Bend, Wisconsin a master of oil painting who first joined the Juried Fine Art Show last year and has quickly become a fan favorite of festivalgoers.

The artists mentioned above, along with many others and vendors, have been key to the success of the Soaring Eagle Arts, Beats & Eats' Juried Fine Art Show sponsored by Corewell Health. For more than 25 years, their contributions have made this event one of the top shows among thousands held across the country.
